**Course Description:** instruction directed to the competent sailing of small sailboats. Boats used are Sunfish, Interlake, Jet 14, Holder 14, Javelin, and Thistle. While the course is oriented toward adults, parents or guardians may enroll youngsters  $\geq 12$  years old. Parents/guardians must provide written permission for those  $< 18$  years old, so we may take these youngsters out on the water.

**Part II:** Individual, On-Water Instruction, Charles Mill Lake: Individual: May 13 through June 24

**On-Water Instruction:** Outside individual instruction is included in the \$25 class fee. To arrange these extra, individual, on-water sailing lessons, students should contact, by email or at the sailing club on Sundays, instructors listed on the next page. Some skipper/instructors can be available on evenings and weekdays as well as on weekends. There is no limit to the number of times students may take advantage of the one-on-one teaching, but students will need to complete this portion of the course, if not a club member, by Sunday, June 24 (students will be considered guests of the club through Sunday, June 24). We urge students to arrange hands-on sessions as soon as they are able after the first Wooster class, and complete as many as possible before the June closing date. Note that students may come to the Mohican Sailing Club for instruction, without an appointment, on any Sunday beginning May 13, at or after 12:00 noon. Someone will be on hand to teach. We encourage students, as a part of their training and experience, to volunteer as crew for our regular Sunday races and general day sailing at the Mohican Sailing Club. Skippers always need extra hands. All who sail do so at their own risk.

## Driving Directions from Wooster to the Mohican Sailing Club on the Southwest Shore of Charles Mill Lake

(From Local Roots on Walnut Street in Wooster):

1. Take Route 30 WEST from Columbus Street in Wooster
2. After approximately 23.5, TURN LEFT onto Route 603 (be careful at this left turn - traffic is coming from several directions)
3. Go 0.5 mile, TURN RIGHT onto Route 430
4. Go 1.7 miles, TURN LEFT onto Harlan Road (at the top of a low hill)
5. Go 1.6 miles, TURN LEFT onto Milligan Road (on straight section of road)
6. Go 0.8 mile, TURN LEFT into Mohican Sailing Club drive

N.B.: these driving distances are approximate, although reasonably accurate.
