Dear Mr. Siegenthaler:


We are glad to know that your group feels the proposed site will prove acceptable and we sincerely hope your anticipated developments at the new site will provide adequately for the needs of your club.

I feel that you need entertain no fears as to later occupancy of your present site by another club. Plans of the District for future development of the peninsula south of the Scott property preclude this possibility as there is a low place which at times will be flooded and we do not feel any club would care to make any investment in a site which at times could not be utilized.

Our survey party has completed the necessary field work at the proposed site and has taken soundings to show the depth of water at the anchorage location. Due to our curtailed drafting force we have not yet been able to prepare a contour map but this will be done as soon as possible.

In the meantime we will keep you advised as to any current developments regarding the transfer to the District by the United States Government of the area in question.
