Dear Mr. Siegenthaler:

We are in receipt of a letter from the United States Engineer office regarding the use by your club of the proposed site on the southwest shore of Charles Mill Reservoir.

This letter states there will be no objection to permitting the club to establish pleasure boat anchorages in the area immediately east of the point, providing they are properly maintained and do not interfere with the operation of the dam, and with the further provision that the United States will not be held liable for any damages due to the operation of the dam.

It is our thought that a lease containing essentially the same conditions as to the one your club held last year be prepared for a three months term for the period April 1 to June 30, 1944 at a rental of \$12.50, which is one-fourth of last year's amount, and if the District is then in a position to do so we will prepare the regular club site lease. If unable to give a regular lease we will renew the temporary lease for another three month's period.

If this arrangement meets with the approval of your club we will prepare and submit to you the temporary lease covering the period to June 30th of this year.
