Dear Mr. Siegenthaler:

Lt. Col. Pockras accompanied us on our annual inspection trip which was made Oct. 21 and 22 and we had an opportunity to discuss with him the matter of your club site.

Unofficially he told us Mr. Brown had discussed the matter with him and that it would come to his attention through regular channels within a few days. The action of his office will probably follow the outline set forth in Mr. Brown's statement at our recent meeting in Mansfield.

We are expecting a letter stating there is no objection to excavating and grading and the construction of a foundation but that no structure can be erected until the District becomes the fee owner of the site.

One of the conditions upon which this approval will be given is that any work done by your club will be at your own sole risk.

From the recent conversation we feel the letter from the U. S. Engineer office will be received by us within a very few days, and just as soon as we receive the formal permission word will be given to you and confirmation will follow by letter to your club.

With our letter to you will be information regarding the limits within which your building is to be located, and we will also give you a reference to a bench mark of known elevation for use by Mr. Rusk.
